Technology is an important tool in our learning community. Sir Robert Borden Intermediate staff use instructional technology as one way of supporting our mission to teach the skills, knowledge and behaviours students will need as responsible citizens in the global community. Through the responsible use of technology, students learn collaboration, communication, creativity, and critical thinking in a variety of settings throughout the school day.

Sir Robert Borden and the OCDSB will continue to support 21st century skills and digital citizenship by using and adding to the the existing bank of Chromebooks available to each class. Unfortunately, cell phones, tablets, and personal gaming devices have proven to be a distraction and have had a negative impact on students' social, emotional, and physical development at school. We believe students should be using their time at school to focus on academic learning, socialization, and character development. As such, students are not permitted to use cell phones (or related devices) in the classrooms, hallways, cafeteria, yard, or locker bay during the school day. Once students enter the building, devices are to be stored in their locker for the remainder of the school day. Students may not keep them in their pockets, purses, bags, etc. This also includes lunch and recess breaks. If your child does not require a cell phone, please leave it at home. A phone dedicated to student use is located in the office and is accessible from 8:30am - 4:00pm daily. Your child will never be penalized academically because they do not have a personal cell phone, device, or computer.

Personal computers may be accessed during classroom time with the explicit permission of the teacher for students who require a computer to access the curriculum. Classrooms have regular access to Chromebooks and a set of ipads will be available for project-specific needs. These devices are for learning purposes only. Social media, games, and entertainment videos are prohibited.
